

Meeting #29

March 1st, 2024

The following reflects the proceedings from twenty-ninth (29th) meeting held of the Software Transparency Foundation on March 1st 2024 at 9am (CET).

The meeting was called to order by Mr. José María Lancho and was held by video conference.

1. Community awareness

Mr. Lancho explains that there are no entities that provide legal certifications for OSS.

Mr. Lancho suggests organizing an awareness session at the bar association. The objective is to address the legal gap in software composition analysis. Mr. Coccia proposes a hybrid activity format since a fully in-person event would increase costs.

Mr. Benito proposes the objective of creating a mailing list with 10-15 participants where a discussion space can be opened.

2. Interactions with OSADL

Mr. Coccia informs that OSADL produces and maintains curated information on licenses. It is worth noting that there is coordination and a good relationship with SCANOSS. OSADL also provides a platform for conducting project audits.

This information would allow adding a new source of licenses to the OSSKB.

On the other hand, Mr. Lancho clarifies that the results would not be conclusive and that they must explicitly include a disclaimer. For this, Mr. Coccia undertakes to review the terms of use for the service provided by the foundation.

It is proposed to include OSADL within the foundation, although it should be coordinated beforehand to agree on the adjustment of terms and conditions of use of the OSSKB service.
